

The Illinois Environmental Protection Agency (IEPA) has issued a Notice of Intent to issue a Preliminary Environmental Impacts Determination (PEID) to the Village of Westmont. The Village of Westmont has applied to the IEPA Public Water Supply Loan Program to finance the Elevated Water Storage Tank Project. The proposed Project consists of constructing a 1 million gallon elevated waterspheroid type storage tank, water main, and other associated improvements to provide additional water storage capacity to meet the Village's average usage.

A Project Summary and PEID document provided by the IEPA is available for review at Westmont Village Hall at 31 W. Quincy St., Westmont, IL 60559. The referenced document contains information including the Project location, description, cost, and environmental impacts. A Public Hearing has been scheduled for Thursday, November 10, 2022 at 6:00 pm at the Village Hall.

This Notice is to provide access to the document and notification of the scheduled Public Hearing to satisfy Section 662.330 of the Procedures for Issuing Loans from the Public Water Supply Loan Program. These documents will be on file at the Village Hall prior to the Public Hearing and for 10 days after the hearing date to allow for public comment on the proposed Project. Public comments will be accepted until 5:00 pm on November 23, 2022 and may be addressed in writing to either:
