Declaring November 15th "World Pancreatic Cancer Day" in the Village of Westmont

**WHEREAS**, every day around the world more than 1000 people will be diagnosed with pancreatic cancer and 985 people will die from the disease; and

**WHEREAS**, pancreatic cancer is the only major cancer with a five-year relative survival rate in the single digits at just 7 percent; and

**WHEREAS**, pancreatic cancer is the 12th most common cause of cancer-related death in men and women across the world; and

**WHEREAS**, the good health and well-being of the residents of Westmont are enhanced as a direct result of increased awareness about pancreatic cancer and research into early detection, causes, and effective treatments;

**WHEREAS**, in 2017 Westmont Park Board Commissioner Diane Main passed away after a long fight with Pancreatic Cancer;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, BY THE VILLAGE OF WESTMONT, that November 15, 2018 be designated as "World Pancreatic Cancer Day" in honor of Park Board Commissioner Diane Main and the hundreds of others that have succumbed to pancreatic cancer here in the Village of Westmont.
