Cold Temperature Safety Advisory: Heating of Apartments

Westmont, Illinois

Date Issued: October 16, 2018

As winter-like temperatures move in, we would like to remind property owners, managers and tenants about the Village of Westmont ordinance for heating of apartments.

From October 1st through May 1st, the minimum temperature in any building, apartment or room shall be 68 degrees Fahrenheit.

All complaints about insufficient heating should be reported to Code Enforcement at 630-981-6200, unless outside of normal business hours, and then to the police department. In the event of an emergency, residents should immediately contact the police department to complain about a violation of this section so that appropriate health and safety measures can be taken.
